Background

- Barents Regions transportion and logistics –project, Working group on Transport and Logistics (BRWGTL)
- Changed geopolitical situation, NATO application (Sweden and Finland). All connections become more important from the point of view of security of supply.
- Finding out the bottlenecks of cross-border traffic flows.
- Solve how the electric aviation will change travel patters and airports



Work packages

WP 1-4: Strengthen the co-operation and develop the models of co-operation further. Fluent and sustainable transport system in the North in all situations, anticipating future opportunities together

Wp 1: Seamless freight transports chains of the future:

 Develop future-oriented and sustainable cross-border freight transport solutions by road in the region (Northern Norway-Gulf of Bothnia), including functional connections between the region and the main international markets

WP 2: Security of supply and co-operation

- form a common understanding of the characteristics that form the basis of a transport corridor, which is important for security of supply, the type of service supply involved, how they are managed and how sufficient transport infrastructure capacity is determined.
- Find out the bottlenecks from the point of view of security of supply on short and long terms
- Prepare proposals that can be used to apply for CEF-funding




Work packages

WP 3: Electric aviation

- to form a joint vision for sustainable regional aviation in the project region.
- to identify potential routes for regional aviation in the project region, analyse how different sustainable aviation technologies fit the regional aviation needs of the region, enhance the knowledge about sustainable aviation among stakeholders and propose policy recommendations for the stakeholders of the region.

WP 4: Green transport corridors

- to analyse the features, functionality and future possibilities of the rail transport corridor from North Karelia via the Tornio-Haparanda border-crossing point to the Norwegian port of Narvik.
- How the investments in north will change the logistics
- Main infrastructure bottlenecks are identified, operative level needs to be clarified
